



HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Alliance Surveying is recognised as providing customers with high quality surveying services.

The health and safety of all workers is of the highest importance and is an integral part of our culture and management systems. We are committed to maintaining a safe and healthy working environment for all Alliance Surveying workers.

Alliance Surveying has a responsibility to, so far as practicable, provide and maintain a working environment in which workers are not exposed to hazards and for ensuring that all applicable requirements of health and safety legislation are strictly adhered to.

It is a core objective of Alliance Surveying that workers are able to work and interact at any worksite locations and be free from any hazards that may cause personal injury or harm.

To achieve this core objective Alliance Surveying will:

- Comply with all applicable health and safety legislative, contractual and industry related requirements.
- Maintain a safe working environment at all worksite locations.
- Establish, implement, maintain and continually improve management systems that comply with the requirements of ISO 45001, the internationally recognized standard for occupational health and safety management systems.
- Establish measurable objectives and targets to ensure continual improvement towards the elimination of work-related injury and illness.
- Ensure safe practices and systems of work are implemented and maintained that:
 - Are relevant to the activity being conducted.
 - Comply with statutory requirements.
 - Promote the involvement of all personnel in the maintenance of a safe working environment.
- Ensure appropriate emergency procedures are established and ensure that all personnel understand the procedures relevant to their activities.
- Provide all training, instruction and supervision that may be required to support the health and safety for all Alliance Surveying workers.

This policy is applicable to all Alliance Surveying activities and workers and is to be reviewed at regular and planned intervals to ensure it remains relevant and appropriate to our business.

All workers have a responsibility to ensure their own safety and health at work and to avoid adversely affecting the safety and health of any fellow worker or member of the general public through any act or omission at work. All workers are encouraged to participate in the development of procedures and ongoing hazard and risk identification.

As Directors we require the full cooperation and commitment of all workers to work with us and help us to implement this policy.
